# 1 What is your photography style?

Know what type of look you like before talking with your potential photographer.

- Do you like dark & moody images? Or do you want your wedding pictures to be bright & airy?
- Do you want some posed pictures with your immediate family? Or do you want all candid images, taken in-the-moment?

If the photographer uses a word or phrase to describe their style, ask what they mean. What will "photojournalist" or "editorial" mean for YOUR wedding day?



# 2 *Can we get together?*

Know their personality. Your wedding photographer will be with you for hours on your big day. Make sure his or her personality is a good fit and they aren't someone who will annoy you or ignore your requests on your big day.



# 3 Can I see a past client's final gallery?

Of course, scouring the photographer's website is the first step, but photographers carefully select the images to be displayed on their website. That's why, rather than seeing a photographer's best two or three images from each of their weddings, seeing a former client's entire gallery gives you the best feel for how your images will look. Just ask!
